Sans Bois Baptist Association Cabin Rules

- 1. The Camp Committee is responsible to enforce all camp and cabin rules.
 - a. The Chairman or his designate is the spokesman for the committee.
 - b. All sponsors and campers are accountable to the committee.
 - c. The sponsors are to assist the committee in the operation of the camp.
- 2. The Bible is a required part of a camper's paraphernalia and is to be with the camper during all classes and services.
- 3. All campers and sponsors are to attend worship services.
- 4. Camp dress code is in effect inside of cabin general access areas at all times.
- 5. All sponsors and campers are to be in the cabin and attend the cabin devotionals. (Unless been asked to speak at another cabin's devotional.)
- 6. All campers are to be in dorm when cabin director announces lights out.
- 7. All campers and sponsors are to be in bed 15 minutes after lights out.
- 8. No food or drinks are allowed in dorms at any time by any one.
- 9. Horseplay of any kind is not allowed in or around the cabin, night or day.
- 10. Each camper is responsible for keeping his/her bunk area clean.
- 11. Campers are required to take showers daily and promote personal cleanliness.
- 12. Each camper is to show courtesy to other campers and sponsors.
- 13. Radios, I-pods, CD players, DVD players, headphones, TV sets, or any other such device are not allowed without prior permission. All such items will be confiscated and stored until person bringing such item departs for home.
- 14. NO cell phone use during class/tabernacle times.
- 15. No camper is allowed in kitchen area without permission.
- 16. All property willfully damaged will be paid for by the person doing damage.
- 17. A camper who continuously breaks rules must meet with the Camp Committee and camper's sponsors. The Committee will determine the seriousness of violation and disciplinary action to be taken. The Committee has the right to send violators home, at the violators churches expense. All campers and sponsors are to adhere to the Camp Committees decisions.
- 18. Camp Committee may from time to time make changes in camp rules due to special circumstances.
