EPHESIANS 1:11-12 THE WAY WHICH GOD WORKS OUT HIS PLAN

We are here face to face with high doctrine again. Paul is repeating the same words he used in vv 4-5. There he was giving us a general view of God's purpose and now he gives us a view of the eternal standpoint. This is the scheme that is applied to us. God is restoring the original harmony that had been broken. That is what we saw in Verse 10 as he unfolded God's great eternal purpose. Verse 11 brings in the details. Paul is simply astounded by these things that are according to the counsel of God's own will. God's way of restoring harmony and unity is to produce Christians. The text is for believers only. Christians have minds that are enlightened. It is only the ones who have the Holy Spirit who can understand these things.

A. THE BASIS

The Greeks hated the Jews. They had the great philosophers, Plato Socrates, and Aristotle. They had their theories for life and the after life. The Greeks saw themselves as superior. They both built walls, curtains

What was it that brought Paul and the Ephesians together? Christ is the answer.
