Zoopoieo—to cause to live, to make alive, to give life Regenerated—an act of God by which a principle of new life is implanted in man, and the governing disposition of the soul is made holy Rom 6:3-4

I no longer have my graveclothes, no longer in that realm.

I have ceased to be dead. There is now a new disposition. It is a creative act of God.
