The Christmas season is upon us, and gift buying and giving is happening all around. You may wonder what giving other people gifts has to do with the birth of our Savior Jesus Christ, and if you haven't thought about it, you should.

Giving is such a central part of a life in Christ. The only way a person can have a relationship with God is by receiving the free gift of Jesus Christ. He is the best gift of all. Those that follow Christ are called to immediately begin a life that is characterized by giving...Giving our time, giving our love, giving our story, giving our resources, giving so that others will be blessed by God in us. So when we give presents at Christmas we are in a small way showing that God is real to us and that He gave us His Son.
