I have a vision where young people are engaged for Christ. They hunger for the Word of God. They excitedly tell their friends the good news of how Jesus Christ died on the cross, so that we could have new life. They spend time in prayer for their church, community, and country. They are sensitive to the needs of others and pour out love through ordinary acts of kindness. They participate in a Christian community that disciplines them. That helps them avoid the common pitfalls of becoming a young adult and holds them accountable to Christian living.

This is the critical time for our young people because if they are not firmly rooted in Christ they will drift away. They will be exposed to the false teaching and promises of a fallen world.
