I want to thank you all for being the body of Christ and for continuing to be lights in the midst of darkness. I want to thank God for not leaving us in quarantine but, entering into it with us. Good Hope Union, we will get through this. As the old saying goes, "a family who prays together stays together." And we will weather this storm together and prayerfully be stronger and better on the other side.
