



- I. Owe **nothing** but love. - v. 8
  - a. Let no debt **remain** outstanding
  - b. Love is a **good** debt to owe.
  
- II. Love, because it **fulfills** all commandments - vv.9-10
  - a. Loving one's **neighbor** fulfills the law - v. 9
  - b. All major "**don't**" commandments are summed up in "Love your neighbor" – v.9
  - c. Love does no **wrong** to a fellow human – v. 10

**The Big Idea:** The only **exception** to the debts that we are to strive to **pay** back is the debt of love, which can never be **repaid**, but which is sure to satisfy God's requirements for treating our **fellow** men.
