“Call on the Name”
Romans 10:5-21

- I. When earning righteousness by law, you’ve got to keep the whole law – v. 5.
- II. Righteousness by faith, however, is easily available through the preached word of faith – vv. 6-17.
 - A. Mouth & heart are essential steps in the salvation process – vv. 6-10.
 - i. Confessing Jesus as Lord with mouth + believing that God raised Him from the dead with heart = salvation
 - ii. With heart – one believes & has righteousness
 - iii. With mouth – one confesses & has salvation
 - B. Placing faith in Jesus will never be lamented– v. 11.
 - C. Same rules of engagement for Jews and Gentiles – everybody who calls gets saved – vv. 12-13.
 - D. Calling on Jesus can only happen as a result of sending missionaries- vv. 14-15.
 - E. Yet not all will believe – v. 16.
 - F. Faith is from hearing & hearing from preached Word v. 17.
- III. **The Jewish nation rejected God’s living Word – vv. 18-21.**
 - A. They have heard – Christ’s word is being preached throughout the whole inhabited world – v. 18.
 - B. They refused to understand – vv. 19-20.
 - C. Their rejection is due to their disobedience and stubbornness, but God yearns for them – v. 21.

The Big Idea: Through the church salvation is easily accessible today to anybody who calls on the name of the Lord through the Living Word.
