“The Consequences of Justification”
Romans 5:1-11**

- I. The **consequences** of our justification – vv.1-2.
 - A. **Peace** with God.
 - B. Access to God’s **grace**.
 - C. Sharing the **glory** of God.
 - D. SO WE BOAST / REJOICE IN OUR **ETERNAL POSITION!**

- II. **Rejoice** in the present – a result of what Christ did for us – v. 3-5.
 - A. We BOAST / REJOICE in ALL OUR **PRESENT CIRCUMSTANCES** – suffering, for the internal perseverance that it produces:
 - i. Suffering – **endurance** – character – **hope**.
 - ii. Hope does not **disappoint**.

- III. Christ’s death – a **demonstration** of God’s love for us – vv. 6-11.
 - A. While we were still **sinner**s.
 - B. At the **right** time.
 - C. Christ died for the **ungodly** – unusual.
 - D. **Redemption** – while we were still **sinner**s, Christ died for us – v. 8
 - E. **Propitiation** – declared righteous by His blood, we will be saved through Him from God’s **wrath**.
 - F. **Reconciliation** – reconciled with **God** through the death of Jesus, we will be saved by His life.
 - G. SO WE BOAST / REJOICE IN WHAT CHRIST DID FOR US!! **PAST**

BIG IDEA: Justification brings peace with God, meaning to suffering, and power over sin.
