Romans 7:21-25

- I. As believers, we are exposed to the struggle with what **is** and what **should** be – vv.21-23
 - A. There is an ever-present **conflict** taking place within between good and evil.
 - B. Deep down inside we love **pleasing** God.
 - C. Our bodies, however, actively **resist** our minds and captivate us to the law of sin.

- II. Each believer must be **rescued** from the power of the flesh – v. 24

- III. **Jesus** provided the rescue and **enabled** us to serve God, while contending with the flesh – v.25

The Big Idea: The struggle between what is and what should be is a sign of being saved and a first **step** on the path of sanctification.
