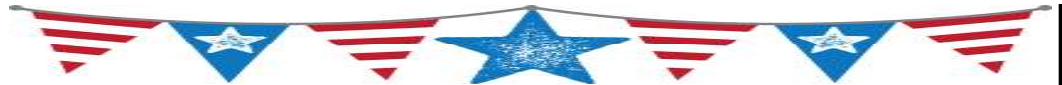

VBS TRAINING DAY

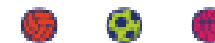
