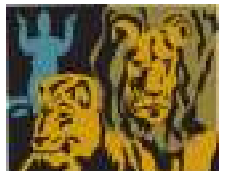

My Dear Church Family,

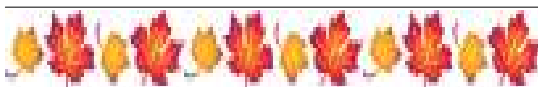
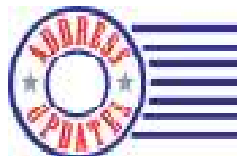
