You Are Mistaken! – Matthew 22:29 says, “...*You are mistaken, not understanding the Scriptures, or the power of God.*”


With that fresh in mind, is it really a problem when we misquote, mistake or take out of context the Word of God? Indeed it is! Let me use the following two illustrations to make this point even clearer.

A preacher was talking to a man at a street meeting who said with a superior air, “Sure, I live it up a little, but we’re not here forever, you know. Even the Good Book says, ‘Eat, drink and be merry!’” The preacher asked him if he had ever read the entire passage he had quoted so glibly. He said, “No.” So the preacher opened his Bible to Luke 12 and read for him the story of the rich man pointing out God’s response: “...*You fool! This very night your soul is required of you; and now who will own what you have prepared?*” (Luke 12:20).

Another preacher by the name of John Gilpin tells the story of a lady who insisted there was one perfect person born into the world besides Jesus. When he asked, “Book, chapter and verse...” She quoted from Psalm 37:37 where it says “...*Mark the perfect man.*” A cursory overview of that verse will put it in the proper context and keep you and me from coming to such a false conclusion as did this lady. The verse, in its context, is an exhortation to watch and observe anyone who is righteous in the eyes of God. This verse has absolutely no reference to a specific individual! How we need to study to show ourselves approved unto God! (2 Tim 2:15).


