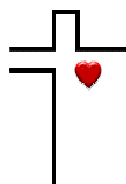
The following will further illustrate the point being made above and will then lead to illustrating another vital Biblical principle.

A dad had a rather strong-willed (code for disobedient) son. On the way to the store he kept telling the child, "Sit down and buckle the seat belt. But the little kid just kept standing in the seat. Again the dad said, "Sit down and buckle yourself in the seat belt." After a time or two more the boy was convinced he had better sit down or trouble would strike. So he slipped down onto the seat, buckled the seat belt and said, "Dad, I'm sitting down on the outside, but I'm still standing up on the inside."

Nehemiah 9:26-27 says, "But they (Israel, the children of God) became disobedient and rebelled against You, and cast Your law behind their backs and killed Your prophets who had admonished them so that they might return to You, and they committed great blasphemies. Therefore You did deliver them into the hand of their oppressors who oppressed them..." We all are too familiar with disobedient children. How and why? We ourselves have been disobedient children. Here then is the point and principle to be made: how we all need to turn from our disobedience. How we all need to be men and women of *the faith*... How we all need to pass this on to the next generations helping them see their need for repentance from being disobedient children of God!

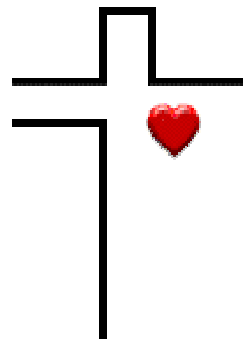
