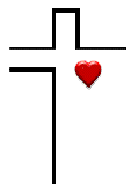

6. You are a marvel because of your spinal cord – no computer system is more rapid in giving instantaneous warnings and reactions.

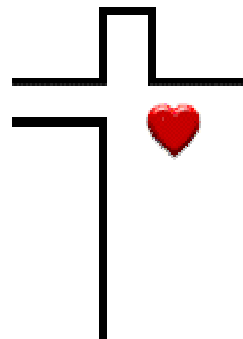
Yes, you and I are the greatest creation of God because we were created in His image. Realizing this great truth of God, we are given the opportunity to live for Him alone. What a marvel!!!

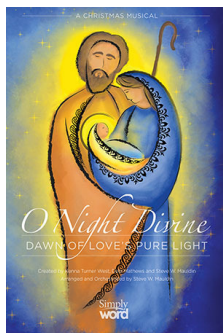


Special Opportunity!
