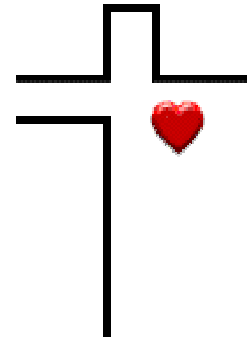
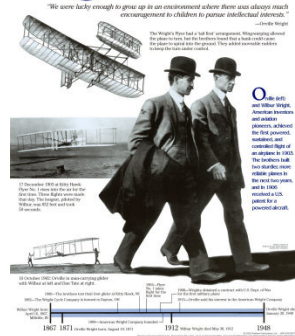

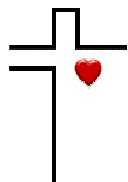

We Welcome Them!

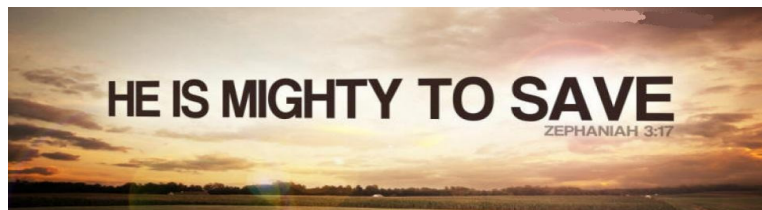

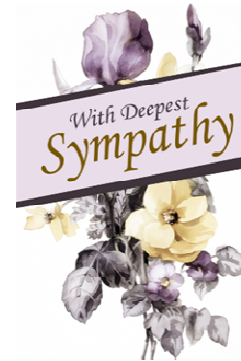
