

An Epistle from Paul:

She should try to understand us, leave us alone, treat us like adults, pamper us, let us have our own way, or have the courage to say “no!” In the course of one day she may be our chauffer, hair dresser, seamstress, maid, cook, gardener, dishwasher, nurse, loan agent and Dear Abby. She gives her work, tears, talent, money, encouragement, patience, wisdom, faith, and most of all her love.
3. **What She Deserves** – She deserves to sit on a silver throne in purple robes with a golden scepter in her hand for she is the humblest, hardest-working, most generous, selfless, praise-worthy and most loving person on the face of the earth.


