Frequently Asked Questions

When did the building program begin?

This has been a vision of the church for many years, and a New Building Committee was formed around six years ago to begin planning for a new facility.

Why does the church believe a building program is necessary?

The current church building no longer meets the spatial needs of the congregation. Also, a bigger facility is necessary to be able to offer the types of training and outreach programs the church feels are crucial to meet the needs of the church and the community.

What does the building program consist of?

Architectural plans have been drawn for five building phases. However, this building program is for Phase One, the construction of an 80 X 80 multipurpose facility at a cost of approximately \$750,000.

How much land does the church own?

The church owns 10 acres from the present building site to Highway 9, with about 5 acres cleared.

What is the purpose of this capital campaign?

This capital campaign is being held to grow the church spiritually and physically as we strive to raise funds to begin construction of Phase One.

What is the theme of this campaign?

Faith in Action

What is the goal of the campaign?

Our Victory Goal is \$150,000 in commitments.

What are the plans for amounts received over and above the Victory Goal?

All money raised will go to the construction of the new building.

When is Commitment Day?
