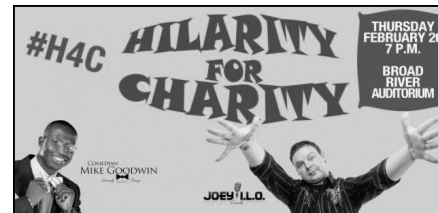
Sunday School Update
