### **Healing Touch**

Mark 5:21-43

Two different stories of healing woven together into a single story.

These two stories of healing couldn't be more different.

- 1. The first major difference comes in the social standing and class differences of those to be healed.
- 2. The second difference has to do with how the healing comes about in the first place, and how these two people came into contact with Jesus
- **3.** The third difference has to do with the condition of the two sick people.
- 4. The final and most striking of the differences in the stories is that Jairus' daughter dies before Jesus gets to her.

The contracts between these two stories are many:

- 1. Rich and poor
- 2. Powerful and powerless
- 3. Asks for healing and takes the healing without asking
- Twelve-year old girl with a sudden illness and a twelve-year chronic illness
- 5. A girl raised from the dead and a woman healed while living

These stories are about salvation - about being delivered from death, and given life in return - about the transforming touch of Jesus.

### The ABC's of Salvation

(3 Step Process to Accepting Jesus as Savior)

- A Admit that I am a sinner (Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23).
- **B Believe** that Jesus is God's Son, that He died for me, and that His death can save my soul (John 3:16, Romans 5:8-10).
- C Confess that He is my Lord and Savior (Romans 10:9-13).

(Example of a prayer for you to follow)

Dear God, I understand that Jesus died on the cross for my sins, so I could be in relationship with You and go to heaven. I'm sorry for living a life without You at the center. Please forgive me for all my sins. I want to follow You for the rest of my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
