Matthew 21:1-11

The triumphant entry of Jesus revealed He was:

The Rightful King

Jeremiah 9:9 - The people of Israel had always understood Zechariah's prophecy to refer to the Messiah, to God's anointed king.

The Victorious King

Psalm 118:25 - The Hebrew words yasha ("deliver, save") and anna ("beg, beseech") combine to form the word that, in English, is "hosanna." Literally, hosanna means "I beg you to save!" or "please deliver us!"...

The Gentle King

Zechariah 9:10 - Jesus comes to greet his subjects, not with pomp and circumstance, but with all humility and meekness.

What does Jesus' triumphal entry mean to us today?

- 1) Believe that Jesus is the Messiah
- 2) Serve him as King
- 3) Proclaim His praises

The ABC's of Salvation

(3 Step Process to Accepting Jesus as Savior)

- A Admit that I am a sinner (Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23).
- **B** Believe that Jesus is God's Son, that He died for me, and that His death can save my soul (John 3:16, Romans 5:8-10).
- C Confess that He is my Lord and Savior (Romans 10:9-13).

Dear God, I understand that Jesus died on the cross for my sins, so I could be in relationship with You and go to heaven. I'm sorry for living a life without You at the center. Please forgive me for all my sins. I want to follow You for the rest of my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
