### The Garden of Gethsemane

Matthew 26:36-46

#### I. Temptation can be overwhelming.

We need to pray for each other.

Jesus us overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death.

#### II. Prayer is key to overcoming temptation.

Jesus prays while the disciples sleep.

Jesus prays for the Father's will to be done.

Jesus persists in prayer.

#### III. The moment of trial will come.

The disciples arise unprepared for temptation.

Jesus rises ready to face what lies ahead.

- 1) Watch and pray so you don't fall into temptation.
- 2) Seek God's will, not your own.
- 3) Don't give up - be persistent in prayer.
- 4) We all fall - lean on God's grace and forgiveness.

### The ABC's of Salvation

#### (3 Step Process to Accepting Jesus as Savior)

**A - Admit** that I am a sinner (Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23).

**B - Believe** that Jesus is God's Son, that He died for me, and that His death can save my soul (John 3:16, Romans 5:8-10).

**C - Confess** that He is my Lord and Savior (Romans 10:9-13).

(Example of a prayer for you to follow)

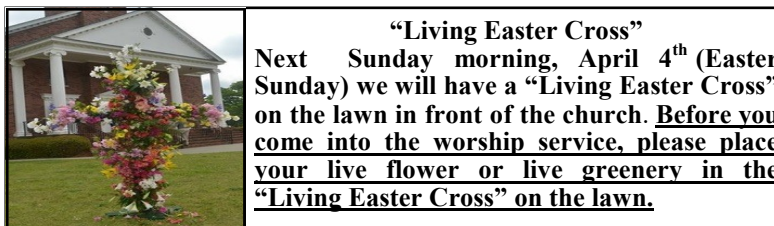
