## Sermon Notes

### HE IS RISEN!

I Corinthians 15:12-22

Christ predicted His resurrection.

The growth of the Christian church confirms the Resurrection.

The testimony of billions of transformed lives through the centuries shows the power of the Resurrection.

The Resurrection sets Christianity apart.

The Resurrection proved that Christ was divine.

The Resurrection revealed Christ's power over death.

The resurrection of the body is the final step in our salvation:

Step #1: We are saved from the penalty of sin. That happens when we trust Christ.

Step #2: We are saved from the power of sin. That happens day by day through the new life given to us by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Step #3: We are saved from the presence of sin. That will happen in the future when our bodies are raised from the dead and transformed by God's power.

## The ABC's of Salvation (3 Step Process to Accepting Jesus as Savior)

**A - Admit** that I am a sinner (Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23).

**B - Believe** that Jesus is God's Son, that He died for me, and that His death can save my soul (John 3:16, Romans 5:8-10).

**C - Confess** that He is my Lord and Savior (Romans 10:9-13).

*(Example of a prayer for you to follow)*

Dear God, I understand that Jesus died on the cross for my sins, so I could be in relationship with You and go to heaven. I'm sorry for living a life without You at the center. Please forgive me for all my sins. I want to follow You for the rest of my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
