On The Road to Emmaus

Luke 24:13-35

There are times when we are tempted to loose hope... vs. 21

They were disappointed disciples who felt their faith slipping away with every step on the road to Emmaus.

Without the resurrection, the cross is nothing but a tragedy, a story without a moral, a drama that ends before the final act.

There are times when we don't see that the Lord is with us...vs. 16

Just because you don't see Jesus doesn't mean He isn't there.

Just because you can't feel Him doesn't mean He has left you.

Just because you think you are alone doesn't mean He is no longer by your side.

There are times when we are slow to believe... vs. 25

We must not make the same mistake these two disciples made or else we too will be fools and slow of heart to believe.

There are times when we are compelled to share what Jesus has done...vss. 33-35

The two disciples couldn't wait to get to Jerusalem to tell others what they had seen and heard.

Once you encounter Christ, nothing will ever be the same again.

The ABC's of Salvation

(3 Step Process to Accepting Jesus as Savior)

A - Admit that I am a sinner (Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23).

B - Believe that Jesus is God's Son, that He died for me, and that His death can save my soul (John 3:16, Romans 5:8-10).

C - Confess that He is my Lord and Savior (Romans 10:9-13).

(Example of a prayer for you to follow)

Dear God, I understand that Jesus died on the cross for my sins, so I could be in relationship with You and go to heaven. I'm sorry for living a life without You at the center. Please forgive me for all my sins. I want to follow You for the rest of my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
