Sermon Notes

God's Top Ten

Exodus 20:1-13

Each of the ten commandments does four things at once:

- 1. Revelation
- 2. Confrontation
- 3. Instruction
- 4. Promise
- 1. The Ten Commandments are absolute commands.
- 2. Each of the Ten Commandments is directed to the individual rather than a group.
- 3. The Ten Commandments were spoken and written directly by God.
- 4. Some groups number the Ten Commandments in different ways.
- 5. The Bible speaks of the Ten Commandments as the two tables of the law.
- 6. There are two versions of the Ten Commandments recorded in Scripture.

Christianity does not start with rules, but the rules do make sense. They are put in place to fulfill our desire for God; not to coerce us into loving God.

The ABC's of Salvation

(3 Step Process to Accepting Jesus as Savior)

A - Admit that I am a sinner (Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23).

B - Believe that Jesus is God's Son, that He died for me, and that His death can save my soul (John 3:16, Romans 5:8-10).

C - Confess that He is my Lord and Savior (Romans 10:9-13).

(Example of a prayer for you to follow)

Dear God, I understand that Jesus died on the cross for my sins, so I could be in relationship with You and go to heaven. I'm sorry for living a life without You at the center. Please forgive me for all my sins. I want to follow You for the rest of my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
