#### Sermon Notes

Commandment Two

#### NO IDOLS

Exodus 20:4-6

Three good reasons why you should not worship an image of God.

First of all <u>it is impossible</u>, in that you cannot represent God accurately by an image.

Secondly, it is absurd or irrational to worship an image of God.

And then thirdly, <u>it is unlawful</u> for you to worship an image of God. It breaks the second commandment.

The reality of God's punishment.

God's punishment for those who hate him may stretch three or four generations, but His love for those who follow Him extends to thousands of generations.

Two simple warning signs that idolatry is creeping into your life:

- 1. When ends becomes means.
- 2. When things become more important than people.

You can not worship the true God unless you come to Him through Jesus Christ His Son.

#### The ABC's of Salvation

(3 Step Process to Accepting Jesus as Savior)

- A Admit that I am a sinner (Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23).
- **B Believe** that Jesus is God's Son, that He died for me, and that His death can save my soul (John 3:16, Romans 5:8-10).
- C Confess that He is my Lord and Savior (Romans 10:9-13).

#### (Example of a prayer for you to follow)

Dear God, I understand that Jesus died on the cross for my sins, so I could be in relationship with You and go to heaven. I'm sorry for living a life without You at the center. Please forgive me for all my sins. I want to follow You for the rest of my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
