Commandment Five

Exodus 20:12

The fifth commandment is reflected in the principles of almost every culture in all places at all times. It is a universally recognized principle that children should honor and respect their parents.

Disobedience to parents will be one of the signs of the end times: 2 Timothy 3:1-2

- 1) You honor your parents by heeding their wise council. Proverbs 18:9
- 2) You honor your parents by living an honorable life. Proverbs 17:25
- 3) You honor your parents by loving them. John 19:26-27
- 4) You honor your parents by submitting to their authority. Ephesians 6:1
- 5) You honor your parents by accepting their discipline and instruction. Proverbs 1:8-9

Parents can help their children to observe the fifth commandment by:

- 1) Instructing them (your children) in God's ways. Deuteronomy 6:7
- 2) Disciplining your children. Proverbs 22:6
- 3) Providing for your children's needs. 2 Corinthians 12:14

- C Confess that He is my Lord and Savior (Romans 10:9-13).
