Sermon Notes

Commandment Seven

You Must Not Commit Adultery

Exodus 20:14

God's reasons for instituting His commandment against adultery are two-fold.

1. God created marriage to be the building block of His creation and of society.
2. God commanded His people to be holy for He is holy, and part of holy living is sexual purity.

Why is adultery such a serious matter to God?

Christopher Ash provides six reasons in his book *Married for God*:

1. Adultery is a turning away from a promise.
2. Adultery leads the adulterer from security to chaos.
3. Adultery is secretive and dishonest.
4. Adultery destroys the adulterer.
5. Adultery damages society.
6. Adultery hurts children.

After being confronted with his sin of adultery, David wrote Psalm 51, a portion of which says, *“Have mercy on me, O God, according to thy steadfast love; according to thy abundant mercy blot out my transgressions. Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin! For I know my transgressions, and sin is ever before me...Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me.”*

The ABC's of Salvation

(3 Step Process to Accepting Jesus as Savior)

A - Admit that I am a sinner (Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23).

B - Believe that Jesus is God's Son, that He died for me, and that His death can save my soul (John 3:16, Romans 5:8-10).

C - Confess that He is my Lord and Savior (Romans 10:9-13).

(Example of a prayer for you to follow)

Dear God, I understand that Jesus died on the cross for my sins, so I could be in relationship with You and go to heaven. I'm sorry for living a life without You at the center. Please forgive me for all my sins. I want to follow You for the rest of my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
