Commandment Eight

Do Not Steal

Exodus 20:15

You could classify the sin of stealing in four ways...

BASIC THEFT

Taking something that doesn't belong to you.

SOFISTICATED STEALING

More complicated than simply physically taking someone's property.

INTANGIBLE STEALING

Taking things from other people that are intangible but still precious and valuable to that person.

SPIRITUAL THEFT

This is when we don't give God what belongs to Him.

Stealing hurts the one who is robbed.

Stealing also hurts the thief.

Stealing hurts our relationship with God.

Philippians 4:19: ***"My God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory."***

Thorough this commandment God is saying to us, *"Let me provide for you. I want you to trust Me, rest in Me, and be contented with Me."*

The ABC's of Salvation

(3 Step Process to Accepting Jesus as Savior)

A - Admit that I am a sinner (Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23).

B - Believe that Jesus is God's Son, that He died for me, and that His death can save my soul (John 3:16, Romans 5:8-10).

C - Confess that He is my Lord and Savior (Romans 10:9-13).

(Example of a prayer for you to follow)

Dear God, I understand that Jesus died on the cross for my sins, so I could be in relationship with You and go to heaven. I'm sorry for living a life without You at the center. Please forgive me for all my sins. I want to follow You for the rest of my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
