Sermon Notes

What does the Passion of Christ mean to YOU?

Romans 8:1-4, 35-39

In Christ there is:

1. No Condemnation!
“There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus.”

Why now? It will always be now for those who are in Christ. Because Jesus Christ, God in the flesh, has been crucified. He paid the price to redeem you from your sentence of condemnation.

2. No Separation!
“Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?....”

Nothing...absolutely nothing can separate you from your relationship with Christ.

In Christ there is:

1. Salvation
“Whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.” (Romans 10:13)

When you come to Jesus Christ and receive him as your Lord and Savior you receive salvation, you receive new life.

2. Justification
“...all are justified freely by His grace through the redemption that came by Jesus Christ.” (Romans 3:24)

What is justification? It is a new standing before God. Without Christ, you stand before God condemned. In Christ, you stand before God justified.

The ABC's of Salvation

(3 Step Process to Accepting Jesus as Savior)

A - Admit that I am a sinner (Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23).

B - Believe that Jesus is God's Son, that He died for me, and that His death can save my soul (John 3:16, Romans 5:8-10).

C - Confess that He is my Lord and Savior (Romans 10:9-13).

(Example of a prayer for you to follow)

Dear God, I understand that Jesus died on the cross for my sins, so I could be in relationship with You and go to heaven. I'm sorry for living a life without You at the center. Please forgive me for all my sins. I want to follow You for the rest of my life. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

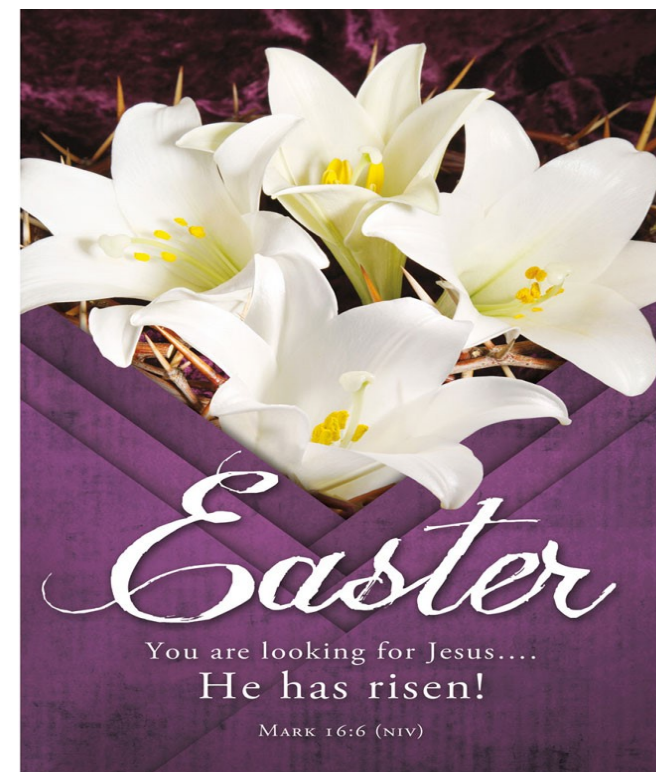
