How will the world end?

1 Thessalonians 5:1-11

In this passage, Paul reminds us of four things we already know about the end of the age.

1. We must know what is coming (verses 1-3)

First, it will come suddenly.

Second, it will be a period of great destruction.

Third, there will be no escape.

2. We must know who we are (verses 4-5)

Christians belong to the light and to the day, not to the darkness or the night. The coming of Christ will clearly reveal those two kinds of people.

3. We must know what to do (verses 6-8)

First, we must be alert.

Second, we must be self-controlled.

Third, we must put on our faith and love.

4. We must know where we are going (verses 9-11)
