The Kingdom in Parables

The Parable of the Sower

Matthew 13:1-9, 18-23

"A sower went out to sow."

The Path

The soil Jesus speaks about isn't really "soil" in the technical sense. It is rather described as a "path" or "road".

The first soil represents those people who do not respond to the Word at all.

The Rocks

The next soil Jesus describes is the rocky soil. It had no depth of soil and when the sun rose, it was scorched, and since it had no root, it withered away.

This is life under spiritual pressure. Pressure to sin especially. Pressure to stop believing what they initially received with gladness.

The Thorny Soil

The soil appears to be fertile for growth. The plant here has a semblance of life, but ultimately is useless.

The third soil is the most dangerous of all and the one where most Christians get snared. This third soil is the thorny soil, and according to Jesus, the thorns are the cares, riches, and pleasures of life.

The Good Soil

Here we have an incredible amount of growth - thirtyfold, sixtyfold, a hundredfold!?

The fourth soil is what God wants all of us to become. Jesus says that the two main ingredients of this kind of soil is that it hears the Word and keeps it.
