Marks of a Healthy Church

UNCONDITIONAL LOVE

1 John 4:7-9 ESV

“Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love. In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him.”

- 1. You need unconditional love for the least of these.
- 2. You need unconditional love for the best of these.
- 3. You need unconditional love for the worst of these.

1 John 4:18: *“There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love.”*

Romans 5:6 & 8...*“For while we were still weak, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly...but God shows his love for us in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.”*

As you experience the fearlessness of being loved by a holy God, you will be able to do what is otherwise humanly impossible: **love the least of these, love the best of these, and love the worst of these.**
