Simeon - A Beacon of Faith

Luke 2:25-35

Through Simeon's words God revealed that...

- 1) Jesus would be the salvation of the world.
- 2) He would deliver truth not only to those in Israel but also to the Gentiles.

God also revealed through Simeon that...

- Some of the Jewish people would believe that Jesus is the "consolation of Israel," and some would not.
- 2) There would be much opposition to Jesus in the future.
- 3) Jesus would reveal the truth.
- 4) Jesus' suffering would cause Mary much personal pain.
