Matthew 2:13-21

I. A sudden crisis

II. Far from home (14-15)

You don't necessarily have to be a long distance from home to feel lonely and isolated.

III. Unspeakable loss (16-18)

We need to be sensitive to the needs of others and point them to God who offers us true comfort and hope.
