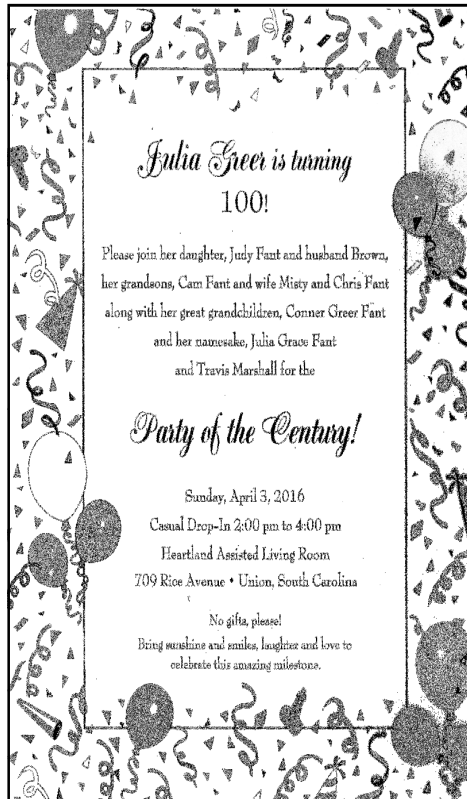
"Living Easter Cross"

The Keenagers will not meet in April due to the Union County Baptist Association Senior Adult Luncheon.

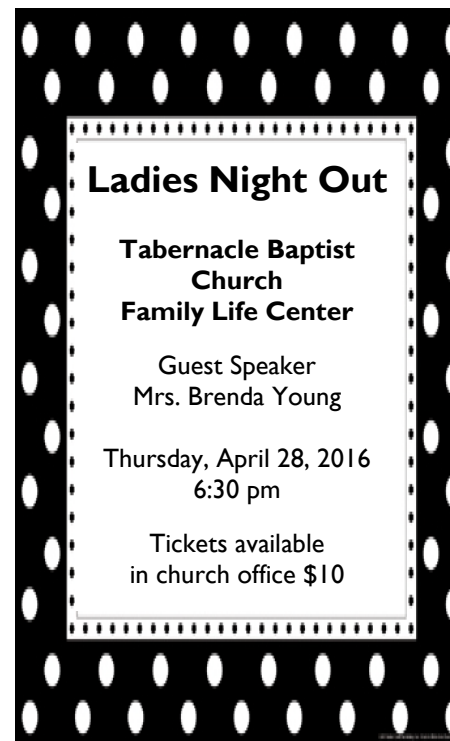
