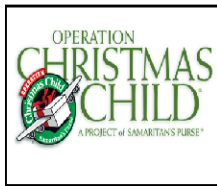

Here is a reminder of things to do and include:

Shop for specific age groups

- Gift ideas: small toys that will fit inside the shoebox, hygiene products (toothpaste, toothbrushes, soap, washcloths, paper, pencils, crayons, small cards, musical instruments, stuffed toys, clothes, hats and balls.
- **DO NOT INCLUDE:** liquid items such as lotion, shampoo, chocolates, toy arm items, toy snakes, anything made of glass, no medicines and no money.
- Label your box; boy or girl and check the correct age.
- Write a note to the child telling them something of yourself and where you live. Always let them know how much you love them and that God loves them more.
- Include **\$7.00** for shipping. If putting in cash, always use an envelope.
- Do not over stuff your box. Use two boxes.
