Over the years I have been asked "What is the importance of Christian baptism?" Christian baptism is one of two ordinances that Jesus instituted for the church. Just before His ascension, Jesus said, "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the *28:19-20*). age." (Matthew instructions specify that the church is responsible to teach Jesus' word, make disciples, and baptize those disciples. These things are to be done everywhere ("all nations") until "the very end of the age." So, if for no other reason, baptism has importance because Jesus commanded

It is to be done in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit - this is what makes it "Christian" baptism.
