I have volunteered to "partner" with our ladies in South Carolina, and we will be going to Jamaica, Montego Bay on July 4-12. Our prayers and expectations are that we will have hundreds of children all ages to attend our Vacation Bible School. Expecting this, we will need many supplies: <u>pencils, glue, tape, paper, etc.</u> I have listed items which will be posted in the Sunday School entrance hall on "sticky notes".
