Dear Executive Board Members:
 Thank you for joining our staff and me in prayer for the Emanuel AME church in Charleston and the families tragically shot and killed by what appears to be a racially motivated act of violence and/or terrorism. I had sent you a copy of a press release I sent out earlier today. Throughout the day I have talked with Dwight Easler, Tommy Kelly, Marshall Blalock, Frank Page at the SBC Executive Committee, and Ken Weathersby, Vice President at the SBC Executive Committee. Ken is the SBC liaison to ethnic and African American churches. I have discussed with these folks and our leadership team at our convention office as to how we could best respond sending a strong statement of love and support of this church in Charleston and the affected families of the terrible shooting. We are responding immediately in ways beyond our prayer support. I have a check of \$25,000 to be issued to the church from the SCBC to help with funeral expenses for the families whose loved ones were killed, including their pastor, Rev. Clementa Pinckney.
