# **Being Present with Your Children this Summer**



Summer provides parents with a wonderful opportunity to explore great parenting resources. <u>Equipping for Life—A</u> <u>Guide for New, Aspiring & Struggling Parents</u> by Andreas and Margaret Köstenberger is one of those resources. The book is written around three basic themes: Parenting needs to be realistic, relational, and responsible. These themes are fleshed out from a Bible-based, God-centered, gospel-focused perspective, giving practical examples from everyday life to which parents can relate.

I believe you will be greatly blessed by reading their book. You may also want to read an <u>interview</u> in which they address other questions/concerns, such as:

How do you counsel parents that you have seen be faithful and still see children not following Christ?

The need to be examining our parenting continually before the Lord with our spouse, asking: "How are we doing?" and "How are kids doing?"

How do you encourage young couples? Where do they go for help?

What counsel are you inclined to give to young parents about their own use of technology? What do you tell the distracted mom and the distracted dad who are engaged with technology all the time?
