Want some encouraging words? I Thessalonians 5:11 says, "Encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing." The context of this verse is found in the preceeding two verses: "For God did not appoint us to



suffer wrath but to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ. He died for us so that, whether we are awake or asleep, we may live together with Him." For the believer, it is always a WIN – WIN! This is why the Apostle Paul could say with confidence, "For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain." - Philippians 1:21.



Men's Study overview - In *Your Life in Christ*, Dr. Neil Anderson shows you how to walk in freedom by faith, according to



There are few greater encouragements to a child's faith than seeing their parents and grandparents worship God with reverence and joy.

Family Worship

When families worship together, children receive an amazing intergenerational experience, and thus have the opportunity to be influenced by the example of their parents and the congregation.

Children are more likely to cherish and delight in the worship of God if they witness that heart for worship in the church. When they see their parents and other adults bow their heads in earnest prayer, or lift their hands in praise, the genuine worship they observe can stir their hearts to worship. Children can observe parents listening intently to the sermon, taking notes and processing the truth they are hearing. They observe this hunger for the Word of God, which can stir the same longing in their own hearts. Learning to sit still in the church service can be difficult for children, but as they begin to listen carefully, they will understand more. Little by little, children will learn about God's greatness, His love, His holiness, His judgment, and His faithfulness. They will begin to know how He works in the world.

What a benefit there is when children witness their mother or father singing with conviction, praying in reverence, listening intently to the sermon, or

receiving the Lord's Supper in joy. In these moments a child witnesses the importance of faith and worship. There are few greater encouragements to a child's faith then seeing their parents and grandparents worship God with reverence and joy.

Ways to help your kids engage in the service...

EXPLAIN! Quietly explain the different parts of the service to your kids so they can understand what is going on.

JOIN IN! Kids learn by copying what they see. So, if you sing, respond, pray, and engage in the service, your kids will too.

WORSHIP BAGS- We will have Worship Bags ready for the kids. Inside these bags you will find crayons, colored pencils, and sharpeners to use with the activity pages. Each week we will put different quiet time activities for them to do. We suggest that you wait until the sermon message begins to let the kids start the doing these. You can also bring any quiet time items from home for them to do.

We will write your child's name on the bag to keep at church, each week you will take out the activities they complete and leave everything else in their bag for your child to enjoy next week.

TikTok

The Scoop

Where Instagram posts are typically centered around creating beautiful Photoshopped scenes, posts in TikTok generally present overdone images. For example, girls attempt to look desirable using excessive and clearly overdone makeup. They even admittedly try to gain attention with their videos and memes

Some girls, known as "egirls," create posts where they're playing video games, taunting boys, or listening to sad songs by Billie Eilish.

Our Take on TikTok

Many of the egirls use their internet identities to become what they think boys their age fantasize about. This is a big concern for us at *Children's Ministry Magazine*. As kids get more involved with the app and copy their peers, what starts as innocent may quickly become inappropriate.

While TikTok does have a separate section for kids under age 13 and reportedly monitors posts to limit inappropriate content, the app isn't foolproof. We definitely recommend close adult supervision of any kids who are using the TikTok app.
