The late Corrie Ten Boom once wrote, "There is no pit so deep, that God's love is not deeper still." The Apostle Paul

wrote in **Romans 8:38-39**, "I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord."

While Corrie was in the pit of the Ravensbrück concentration camp during World War II, these words are what carried her through the horror and hardship. It was actually her sister Betsie, right before her death, who said to Corrie this quote, "There is no pit so deep, that God's love is not deeper still." Miraculously, Corrie was spared the gas chamber and was released from the camp due to a clerical error (and the mercy of God!)

I would like to modify her quote just a bit. "There is no pit so deep, that God's <u>grace</u> is not deeper still." Like David Crowder wrote, "If His grace is an ocean, we're all sinking..." I have been studying Romans chapter 7 and am reminded of the grace of God when we don't measure up. I agree with the late Rich Mullins when he wrote, "So if I stand let me stand on the promise that You will pull me through. And if I can't let me <u>fall on the grace</u> that first brought me to You." In Romans 5:20, the Apostle Paul writes, "But where sin increased, grace increased all the more."

Like Matt Maher writes in his song "Lord, I Need You:" "Where sin runs deep, Your grace is more. Where grace is found is where You are. And where You are, Lord I am free. Holiness is Christ in me!" Beloved, rest in His grace. His grace is enough!
