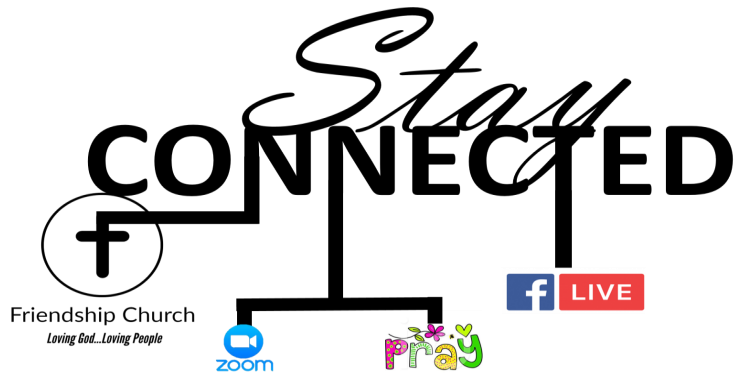

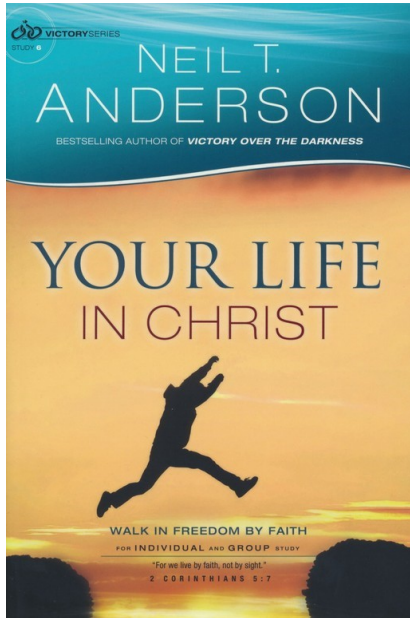

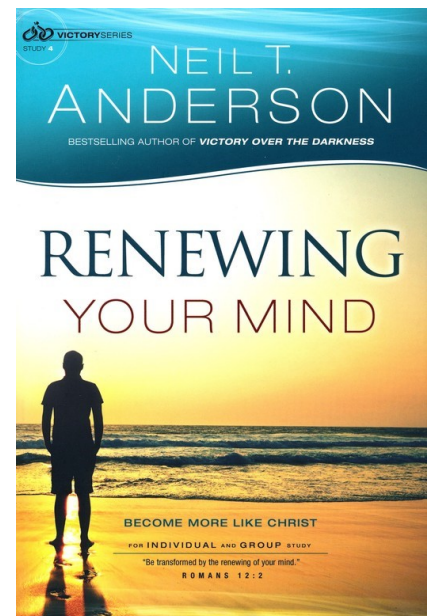

Jesus Healed a Man Who Was Blind John 9

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Jesus gave sight to a man who was blind.
- Jesus said the man's blindness was an opportunity for God to show His power.
- The religious leaders threw the now-seeing man out of the synagogue because he had faith in Jesus.

KEY PASSAGE: Isaiah 53:4-5

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- What does it mean to be spiritually blind?
- How can we gain spiritual sight?
- What are ways God has used hard times to show His power in your family's lives?

FAMILY ACTIVITY:

- Use pillows and cushions to make an obstacle course. Challenge your family to complete it while wearing a blindfold. Talk about spiritual blindness and how Jesus heals us.

CHRIST CONNECTION: Our sin makes us unable to see the truth about God. Jesus came as a light in a dark world. He came to give us sight—true understanding of God and His kingdom. Those who trust in Jesus see who He is and worship Him.

Praying with Kids

Family prayer time doesn't have to be complicated. Try to establish times to pray together every day. At dinner time, or before bedtime. The important thing is to **DO IT**.

And keep trying until it becomes a habit. No matter how uncomfortable you feel doing this at first, God will bless you and your family for it. Also, see where you can weave everyday conversations into "God sightings". These are when you look for the evidence of God in things like a sunset, a rainstorm, a laugh, a kind word, a kind deed, and a tasty snack. Children begin to see that God comes out of the Bible and into their everyday life.

I want to encourage you today... keep your eyes open for a God sighting. And when you do... you'll start seeing God's hand even in the midst of your everyday mundane.

Here is an easy way to get started praying with your family. Remember the acronym **P.R.A.Y.**

P.- Praise and Thanks-Encourage each family member to share one "God Sighting" they have seen, and thank God for it.

R.- Repent- ask God to forgive you for something that you have done that makes Him sad.

A.- Ask God for one thing you need or someone else may need.

Y.-Yield- slow down, listen, what else is on your heart? Do you think God is teaching you something new about Himself? Is there someone else that you want to for?
