


Sharpen your defense against the enemy. Satan, the author of evil and the father of lies, relentlessly attacks the children of

Our Bible lesson this week is Jesus Calms the Storm

BIBLE STORY SUMMARY:

- Jesus and His disciples got into a boat to cross the Sea of Galilee
- A violent storm came on them, and Jesus was asleep.
- The disciples cried out in fear and woke Jesus.
- Jesus calmed a storm to show the disciples He is God.

Jesus' disciples knew Jesus was a good man and a good teacher. But when Jesus calmed the wind and the waves, He showed His disciples that He is also God. God rules the sea and stills its waves. (Psalm 89:9)

FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:

- What situations make you feel afraid?
- How can you trust Jesus through scary situations?
- Why is it good to know Jesus is God?
- Discuss the Bible story and remind your kids that Jesus is trustworthy. He is more powerful than anything or anyone else.

Jesus' miracles were part of His purpose in bringing glory to the Father. His miracles proved that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God. They strengthened people's faith and met people's needs. Through Jesus, God did what is impossible for us to do on our own. He provided forgiveness, salvation, and eternal life. As you talk with your kids, seize the opportunity to share the gospel. Help them understand the truth the disciples did not yet fully grasp. Who is this man? He is the Messiah, the Savior, and the Son of God.

Vision-oriented Parenting

What are your dreams and aspirations regarding the faith of your children?

Vision-oriented parents think about and act according to what they want to be true of their children 10, 20, and 40 years from now. Their priorities are shaped by asking questions like:

What do we want our children to know and understand about God and His Word? And about the gospel? What marks of faith and spiritual maturity do we want them to have?

What verses of the Bible do we want them to be able to quote from memory by the time they graduate from high school?

What kind of husband and father, or wife and mother do we want them to be?

How would we want them to respond when tragedy strikes or when they face suffering in their lives?

What do we want them to be trusting in when they are faced with difficult situations?

What will fortify them against the temptations of culture, and world views?

So, what can parents and grandparents do to guide and inspire the next generation toward mature faith in Christ?

Develop a vision statement for your own family and communicate it to your children. Think about framing it and hanging it in a prominent area of the home where you can all be reminded of it. Revisit it from time to time.

Establish family routines and habits that place the highest priority on knowing God's Word, faith in Christ, and growing in His ways. What will be the non-negotiable things that are needed?

Set age-appropriate spiritual goals for your children. Teach, train, and pray toward those goals.

Commit yourselves to personal discipleship, a small group Bible study which will lead you toward equipping, encouragement, and accountability necessary to navigate the journey through parenting.

Be intentional, it will not just happen. Ask yourself "how many summers do I have left with my children before they leave the nest?"

The days are long, but the years are short!
