This Sunday's Gospel Project Lesson (small groups) "Jesus the Savior (Gospels)

In the beginning, the all-powerful, personal God created the universe. This God created human beings in His image to live joyfully in His presence, in humble submission to His gracious authority. But all of us have rebelled against God and, in consequence, must suffer the punishment of our rebellion: physical death and the wrath of God.

Thankfully, God initiated a rescue plan, which began with His choosing the nation of Israel to display His glory in a fallen world. The Bible describes how God acted mightily on Israel's behalf, rescuing His people from slavery and then giving them His holy law. But God's people—like all of us—failed to rightly reflect the glory of God.

Then, in the fullness of time, in the person of Jesus Christ, God Himself came to renew the world and to restore His people. Jesus perfectly obeyed the law given to Israel. Though innocent, He suffered the consequences of human rebellion by His death on a cross. But three days later, God raised Him from the dead.

Now the church of Jesus Christ has been commissioned by God to take the news of Christ's work to the world. Empowered by God's Spirit, the church calls all people everywhere to repent of sin and to trust in Christ alone for our forgiveness. By God's grace in Christ, repentance and faith restores our relationship with God and results in a life of ongoing transformation.

The Bible promises that Jesus Christ will return to this earth as the conquering King. Only those who live in repentant faith in Christ will escape God's judgment and live joyfully in God's presence for all eternity. God's message is the same to all of us: repent and believe, before it is too late. Confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe with your heart that God raised Him from the dead, and you will be saved.



Around age 22, my parents gave me my first "real" camera....a Pentax K1000. They had both been taking classes from the Daisy company photographer. So, they decided to introduce me to that new world of looking at everything through a different lens! My go-to camera had been the Fujifilm Quicksnap or Kodak FunSaver. Lightweight and easy to use, but the quality of the picture could be less than optimal. The Pentax was heavier and cumbersome to use, especially if you had a flash unit or special zoom lens attached. But the pictures it produced were fantastic. That is.....if--you had it focused properly. Anyone knows that the lens in a camera or your own eye that is out of focus is not good at all. To take a good picture, or see well with your eyes, the lens has to be focused correctly.

With Pharaoh's army in hot pursuit, and finding themselves standing on the brink of the Red Sea....the Israelites were anything but happygo-lucky at their dire predicament. Without a fleet of Royal Caribbean cruise ships waiting to take them on an exciting fun-filled excursion, they were in panic mode! After rescuing them from Egypt through the ten plagues (chapter 7-13), God led them out and began preparing them to enter the wilderness. But as the challenges mounted against them they began to lose heart....and their focus. Moses lost his temper a few times, but never his focus. He knew God had a plan and they were in constant dialogue discussing those plans.

Do you find yourself disillusioned with the news of the day or where your focus may be? Are you talking to him about it, gaining his perspective? When I remind myself of all the many situations throughout the Bible of God's people being in...that seemed impossible, then I quickly put my trust in His awesome promises of His presence, His power, His faithfulness, His sovereignty, His plan. Without the hope of his Word, we can definitely lose our focus to the things that are temporary rather than the things that truly last for eternity.

New 10-Week Men's Bible Study begins Wednesday, October 14 at 6:30pm


"Freedom In Christ: A 10-Week Life-Changing Discipleship Course"

Need Stability This School Year? Look to Scripture

Every school year has its challenges, but this year is one of a kind. Are you and your kids feeling a bit tossed about and in need of an anchor?

At the start of this school year, I saw a video of a music teacher expressing how she feels about distanced learning. Wanting to demonstrate through song, she began strumming a pleasant tune her ukulele with a smile on her face Then, without warning, she unleashed an agonizing scream! Can you relate to her 2020 school-year vibes?

Every year has its challenges, but

has been one of a kind. Are you and your kids feeling a bit tossed about by the challenges of the year and in need of an anchor? What if you decided to anchor this school year in Scripture?

The stability of Scripture this school year

In my early school days, my mom crafted a simple melody, quickly coined as our "family song." It paraphrased <u>Psalm 119:9-11</u> for lyrics: "How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your word. With my whole heart I seek you; let me not wander from your commandments! I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you." These particular verses reminded me to anchor myself in God's Word, during the school year and otherwise. It helped solidify my confidence in Scripture as a sure stability and aid for living a God-honoring life. Befriending the Bible keeps you steady.

Especially with so many kids "working from home" right now, what an opportunity you have to point them to God's Word! Each month you could focus on a different passage to dwell on and...

- bring it up in your prayers.
- text it to your older kids once a week.
- challenge everyone to memorize it together.
- find a podcast on the month's verse and listen while you're driving to the store together.
- talk about it at the dinner table.

There are so many incredible passages you could pick, but here are a few verses and theme suggestions to pray and think on this school year:

August: Rest

"In returning and rest you shall be saved; in quietness and in trust shall be your strength" (Isaiah 30:15) I've held fast to this verse for the last year. When I'm racing to keep up and weary from trying, it reminds me to physically and spiritually pause. Let this verse remind your kids to rest in God this school year. Resting looks like giving up our pride, submitting to God's lead, and trusting in His timing.

September: Praise

"I will bless the Lord at all times; his praise shall continually be in my mouth" (Psalm 34:1).

Do you think to praise God? My Mom would have me and my sister popcorn off different attributes of God to give Him praise and remind ourselves of His character. Things like: Creator, Loving, Gentle, Forgiving. What habits of praising God can you instill in your family this school year?

October: Salvation

"What must I do to be saved?" And they said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household" (Acts 16:30-31).

What a beautifully simple truth. Maybe this school year will be the one your child believes in Jesus. Give your children space to ask questions and pray your children will believe in Jesus, not just know about him.
