From Pastor Mike...



Joy to the world – the Lord has come! But how can you have joy when there is so much pain in the world? How can you have joy when there is so much suffering and brokenness? These are honest questions.

Psalm 102 is a prayer for those who are overwhelmed and for all the discouraged who come to pour out their hearts before the Lord. "Lord, listen to my prayer! Listen to my cry for help! You can't hide Your face from me in the day of my distress. Stoop down to hear my prayer and answer me quickly, Lord! For my days of happiness have gone up in smoke. My body is raging with fever, my heart is sick, and I'm consumed by this illness - withered like a dead leaf. I can't even eat. I'm nothing but skin and bones. Nothing's left of me but whispered groans. I'm depressed, lonely, forgotten, and abandoned. I'm sleepless, shivering in the cold, forlorn and friendless, like a lonely bird on the rooftop. My every enemy mocks and insults me incessantly. They even use my name as a curse to speak over others! Because of Your great and furious anger against me all I do is suffer with sorrow, with nothing to eat but a meal of mourning. My crying fills my cup with salty tears! In Your wrath you have rejected me, sweeping me away like dirt on the floor. My days are marked by the lengthening shadows of death. I'm withering away and there's nothing left of me."

(verses 1-11, The Passion Translation).

Do you ever feel this way? The writer of this Psalm (possibly David) poured out his lament before the Lord. He vented vertically. Then, after this catharsis moment, he writes in verse 12:

"But then I remember that You, O Lord, still sit enthroned as King over all! The fame of Your name will be revealed to every generation."

The rest of the Psalm is a litary of praise as we remember the Lord has come and the Lord is King and the Lord will come again to make all things new. We have a hope that goes far beyond this old broken, dying world. We need to remember that God is still on His Throne – His kingdom will come, His will will be done – here on earth as it is in heaven.

Brothers and sisters, let the word of Christ dwell richly in your hearts and keep on encouraging one another as our redemption draws near! I love you all,

In the beginning, the all-powerful, personal God created the universe. This God created human beings in His image to live joyfully in His presence, in humble submission to His gracious authority. But all of us have rebelled against God and, in consequence, must suffer the punishment of our rebellion: physical death and the wrath of God.

Thankfully, God initiated a rescue plan, which began with His choosing the nation of Israel to display His glory in a fallen world. The Bible describes how God acted mightily on Israel's behalf, rescuing His people from slavery and then giving them His holy law. But God's people—like all of us—failed to rightly reflect the glory of God.

Then, in the fullness of time, in the person of Jesus Christ, God Himself came to renew the world and to restore His people. Jesus perfectly obeyed the law given to Israel. Though innocent, He suffered the consequences of human rebellion by His death on a cross. But three days later, God raised Him from the dead.

Now the church of Jesus Christ has been commissioned by God to take the news of Christ's work to the world. Empowered by God's Spirit, the church calls all people everywhere to repent of sin and to trust in Christ alone for our forgiveness. By God's grace in Christ, repentance and faith restores our relationship with God and results in a life of ongoing transformation.

The Bible promises that Jesus Christ will return to this earth as the conquering King. Only those who live in repentant faith in Christ will escape God's judgment and live joyfully in God's presence for all eternity. God's message is the same to all of us: repent and believe, before it is too late. Confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe with your heart that God raised Him from the dead, and you will be saved.

The Lottie Moon Christmas Offering® is an annual offering collected by believers around the world to support international missions. The offering was officially named in 1918 by Woman's Missionary Union in honor of the missionary to China who urged churches to start it and give sacrificially.

This offering is unique from other mission offerings in that 100% of gifts provide for missionaries all over the world. It is a valuable part of Southern Baptists' 175-year history of reaching the nations with the gospel and vital to reaching the vision of a multitude from every language, people, tribe and nation knowing and worshiping our Lord Jesus Christ (Revelation 7:9).



Some of the areas we will cover in the course include:


· how we became brand-new people from the inside out when

Friendship K.I.D.s Korner News



Most of us would agree that the Christmas season can be quite chaotic. It is easy to get caught up in the hustle and bustle and lose sight of why we celebrate. That is why it is important for us to be intentional in

pointing our kids to Jesus during this Christmas season. Dedicate time to worship God as a family and explore the meaning of Christmas. Consider using this short devotion from Lifeway to lead your family in a time of worship.



Open your Bible to Luke 2. Read <u>Luke 2:1-20</u> aloud or designate a child to read aloud.

- Ask: "Why do we celebrate Christmas?" Explain that we celebrate Christmas to honor the birth of Jesus.
- Ask: "What makes Jesus' birth different from any other baby's birth?" Remind family members that the Son of God was in heaven with God but came to earth as a human baby. Pick up a wrapped Christmas gift. Challenge family members to think of what it would be like to try and put the entire world in a gift box. Explain that Jesus is the mighty, all-powerful God who created everything but He came to earth as the most tiny and helpless of all human forms.
- Ask the big picture question: "Why was Jesus born?" Say the answer together as a family, "Jesus was born to rescue us (from sin)." Explain that we need a Savior. As sinners, we deserve to spend forever apart from God because of our sin. Jesus kept all of God's laws perfectly while He was on earth. Jesus did not deserve to die, but He took God's punishment we deserved and died on the cross in our place.

Ask: "What makes Jesus' birth good news?" Explain that because Jesus came to earth, we can be saved from sin. Jesus rose from the dead, and one day, He is coming back to make everything new and right.

Prayer: God, thank You that because of Jesus we can celebrate Christmas. As we do all the fun things that come with Christmas, help us remember Jesus most of all. Thank You for loving us so much that You sent Your very own Son to earth as a baby so that we could be saved from our sin and can spend forever with You. We love You! Amen.
