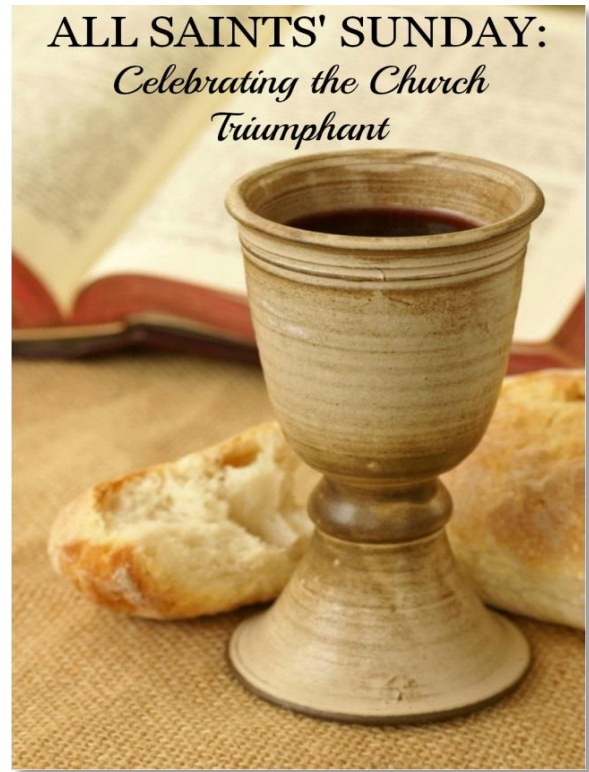

The Apostle's Creed
