please ring the doorbell or call at 913-294-2400. (If staff needs to be quarantined, this process will be changed.)

- ⇒ There will be no access into the building before or after office hours.

CONGREGATIONAL CARE

- ⇒ Our Deacons Care Team will continue to focus on care for our congregation, while taking precautions to protect everyone's health and prevent the spread of the virus. Care Team members will diligently wash hands before and after every visit in delivery of needed supplies or encouragement.
- ⇒ While care facilities are on lock down, "visits" will be made via e-mails, personal calls, texts, cards/notes.
- ⇒ We are initially focusing with those over 60, but will welcome calls with needs from any in our church family and friends at this time. Our main concern is to remain connected with our congregation with care and love.
