Spread It Out Before the Lord

Like everyone of us, King Hezekiah did some things well, but also failed miserably in other areas. One of the wisest things he did is found, interestingly, in the prophet Isaiah's account of history - this story is found in chapter 37.

Here's the scene: Sennacherib, king of Assyria, has laid waste to just about every nation and people who stood in his way: Where is the king of Hamath, the king of Arpad, the king of the city of Sepharvaim, or

of Hena or Ivvah? (Isaiah 37:13). Yup, he's right; they no longer exist. And now he threatens Israel in a brash and arrogant letter meant to buckle the knees.

Earlier in this chapter after hearing the words of this letter, Hezekiah had humbled himself before God because of this king's threats to both Israel and her God: he tore his clothes and put on sackcloth and went into the temple of the Lord, as did all his officials and servants. His only hope was that a remnant might survive.

The prophet Isaiah then assures King Hezekiah that God will prevail on behalf of Israel, and that he should simp-

ly trust in the Lord. But Hezekiah is still shaking in his boots. Sennacherib means business and things are looking bleak for Jerusalem and the nation.

So Hezekiah does something we should take note of: Hezekiah received the letter from the messengers and read it. Then he went up to the temple of the Lord and spread it out before the Lord. (Isaiah 37:14)

This is an action of faith and courage. He had heard about the letter; now he *receives* it, he *reads* it, and he *spreads* it out before the Lord. This is so cool.

It took guts to receive it instead of denying its existence, something I might be tempted to do. But then to *read* all the nasty and intimidating threats from this Hitler-esque king? Hezekiah was scared, yes, but he was facing down his fears.

Good quote attributed to several different people: Courage is not the absence of fear, but the judgment that something else is more important than fear. Hezekiah knew that something else more important than fear was God's name and reputation.

I love the sincere, symbolic gesture of spreading the letter before the Lord. Perhaps you have some major (or minor) threat to your life or well-being. How can you symbolically *spread it out before the Lord*? So that not only are you acknowledging its difficulty and stress on you, but moreover, you are entrusting this situation to God's will, knowing that he cares for you.

Hezekiah then doubles down in his prayer to God: It is true, Lord, that the Assyrian kings have laid waste all these peoples and their lands... ²⁰ Now, Lord our God, deliver us from his hand, so that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that you, Lord, are the only God.

Isaiah 37:14-17.20

And Hezekiah prayed unto the Lord, saying, O Lord of hosts, God of Israel, that dwellest between the cherubims, thou art the God, even thou alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth: thou hast made heaven and earth. Incline thine ear, O Lord, and hear; open thine eyes, O Lord, and see: and hear all the words of Sennacherib, which hath sent to reproach the living God. Now therefore, O Lord our God, save us from his hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that thou art the Lord, even thou only.

Again, no denial here: What Sennacherib says is true – he has triumphed over all these kings and laid waste to everyone and everything in his path.

But, O Lord our God, all you are and all you say – your promises, your character, your power – **these are all** *true-er* than anything this man, or any person, can ever claim.

And God does deliver Hezekiah and the people of Israel. Just as he promises to deliver us.

God's character, his promises, his presence: Who the Lord is far exceeds whatever may come our way to-day, or in the days to come. He is true-er, stronger,

Our Vision

To grow in Christ and become like Him. We seek to teach and demonstrate the gospel each time we gather with children. We pray they may be light in their world and that their light may grow brighter each day with the help of the Holy Spirit. We also dedicate ourselves to supporting the family unit as primary teachers of the faith and the conduit through which God shows His love and reveals His character.

What We Offer

Nursery (0-3) - Nursery is available during worship each Sunday morning and for some special events (dates and additional information will be provided as needed). Our focus is to provide loving care for our youngest children and age appropriate activities introducing them to the God who loves them.

Children's Church (Preschool-5th grade) – Children's Church is offered during worship each Sunday. At a designated time during the service (usually following a children's message), children are dismissed to the back of the sanctuary to meet their adult leaders. Children may be picked up in the children's educational wing following the close of worship. Each week children learn about the Big Bible Story through creative storytelling and extension activities. On months with a 5th Sunday, children remain in worship.

Family Night & Kingdom Kids (all ages) – Two times a year, fall and spring, a midweek program is offered on Wednesday evenings that includes a meal, worship, and Bible-based activities for all ages. Dates, times, and other necessary information will be provided in the weeks prior to each session.

Vacation Bible School (Preschool – 5th grade) – Each summer a Vacation Bible School program is offered. Dates and other information regarding VBS will be provided in the Spring.
